CHAPTER I

A. Background of The Study

The jungle book has remained popular, partly through its many adaptations for film and other media (Wikipedia, 2021). Rudyard Kipling. Moreover, the famous tale began as a series of short stories written by author Rudyard Kipling, and later published as a book in 1894. Many movies based on it have been made since and Mowgli: Legend of the Jungle is the latest version. (Newsround BBC, 2021) Some prestige above shows that the movies are great to be watched. But most of all the researcher really likes the story in the movie because this movie creates many characters that brings the moral values

for each character they act in that movie. The researcher is sure about the movie characters to be explored since seeing the synopsis of the movie as shared by Tyssa Madelina on December 2018. (KapanLagi.com, 2021) Many characters shown in the movie started from human characters and also the animals. This movie shown us the background of India Land with its traditional habits such as hunting and their believes at that time. Each character brings each own message in it, especially for the moral messages that the researcher focused on. This movie would be very suitable when it is watched by the students of secondary or senior high school since they are suitable with the movie content. They can learn the moral values from the movies with the guidance of the teachers. Students will know which character brings good impact and which characters should be avoided in their real-life situations.

Many directors of movie ever tried to make the novel into movie. Such as The Jungle book (1967), Rudyard Kipling's The jungle book (1994), The jungle book 2 (2003), The jungle book (2016), Animated series like TaleSpin (1990-1991), Jungle cubs (1996-1998), Direct to video, the jungle book: Mowgli's Story (1998) And also this novel inspired some video games. This movie has ever changed the title from the original one "Jungle book" into Mowgli: Legend of the jungle which has made some directors take turn in directing or handling this movie.

The filmmakers felt that the story was rich enough – and the technology sufficiently advanced – to justify a new version (Joe Ursell, 2016) means that this film would be very interesting and awesome with many advances of film technology with great director. And finally, Andy Serkis did as the final director of this movie. Andy Serkis is an actor, director and author that is known for his performance capture roles comprising motion capture acting, animation and voice work for such computergenerated characters in some movies such as Lord of the rings film trilogy (2001-

2003), The hobbit: An unexpected Journey (2012). Serki has his own motion capture workshop, the imaginarium Studios in London, which he used for his directional debut.

Second, the movie Mowgli: The Legend of the Jungle has won many awards as far as he involves in movies world. For the movie that he directed Mowgli: The legend of the Jungle, it became the nominee in some prestige awards, such as best visual effects, best sound effects, best animated characters in CinEuphoria Awards (2019), best fantasy or adventure Tv spot in Golden Trailer Awards (2019), British/ Irish actor of the year in London Critics Circle Fil Awards (2019), Excellence in Title Design in SXSW Film Festival (2019).

Third, since this movie nominated as best fantasy or adventure tv spot in Golden Trailers Awards, this movie contains moral messages for everyone especially for students. Most of the movies' parts show rich characters that provide moral messages as we can see from the film synopsis (by Tyssa Madelina on December 2018 in (KapanLagi.com, 2021) which hopefully can be obtained by the students well. This movie offers interesting motion pictures with many messages that can be used as teaching media. This movie shown us the background of India Land with its traditional habits such as hunting and their believes at that time. Each character brings each own message in it, especially for the moral messages that the researcher focused on. Students should socialize easily and are more sensitive and emphatic of the surrounding environment. This can be gained through the way how the students look at the knowledge, authority, power and social values. As a result, the author conducted this research, the author hopes that the audience does not only see or watch the result of a literature but also must take the moral values in it. Since not all the literary works are good to imitate but at least we take a good advantage by getting the good ones in it and think critically what the author really implies in the movie.

B. Identification of The Problems

There are some difficulties faced by the students to find, describe and analyze the intrinsic elements and moral values of the movie Mowgli: The Legend of the Jungle. This movie took place in different country and has different cultural background so that by analyzing the characters in the movie, hopefully will create students' critical and deep thinking to figure out each of the intrinsic elements and the moral values and also to figure what theoretical implications that can be applied in English Language Teaching.

C. Limitation of The Study

This study is limited to investigate intrinsic elements and moral values depicted in the movie entitled "Mowgli: Legend of the Jungle" directed by Andy Serkis and the theoretical implication for English Language Teaching as well.

D. Focus of The Study

This study is focused on intrinsic elements and moral values found in the movie entitled "Mowgli: Legend of the jungle" by Andy Serkis and theoretical Implication of English Language Teaching.

E. Formulation of The Problems

Based on the focus above, there are three problems formulated in the movie entitled *Mowgli: Legend of the Jungle* directed by Andy Serkis, namely:

- 1. What intrinsic elements are found in the movie entitled *Mowgli: legend of the Jungle* directed by Andy Serkis?
- 2. What moral values are depicted in the movie entitled: Mowgli: Legend of the jungle?

3. What theoretical implication of this study can be applied in English Language Teaching?

F. Significances of The Study

This study may give some significances theoretical and practical; they are as mention below:

1. Theoretical

Hopefully, this study is expected to give better understanding and more knowledge and contribution to the development of moral values that was taken from "Mowgli: legend of the jungle" Movie. The researcher also hopes that the result of the study can give information to the readers about how to study more or deeper about moral values in a movie.
